



The Dukes is delighted to be working with LUNG Theatre, Barnardo's and local schools this autumn on a Young Carers Takeover; an ambitious collaboration that aims to bring together local young carers and raise awareness for what they do through creative workshops.

The project, supported by the Victoria Wood Foundation, aims to address the social isolation and lack of support faced by many young carers across the district as well as create a legacy resource that can be shared and used to inform others about the challenges and experiences of young carers.

YOUNG PRACTITIONERS

Our Young Practitioners programme is open to 18-21-year-olds seeking to gain workplace experience and training, mentoring, creative experiences, and experience-based learning over the course of an academic year. Young people can gain qualifications and work experience to prepare them for the future.

Young Practitioners bridges the step into higher education and/or formal training and is particularly targeted towards those who may find this step challenging.


